PROCLAMATION NO. 15-2107

Carolina Beach Town Council Proclamation of State of Emergency

Pursuant to Chapter 2, Article IV, Section 2-63 "Declaration of Emergency", The Carolina Beach Town Council has determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Carolina Beach Code of Ordinances exists in Carolina Beach.

The Carolina Beach Town Council proclaims the existence of a State of Emergency in Carolina Beach due to the approaching Hurricane Joaquin.

The Carolina Beach Town Council hereby orders all town law enforcement officers and all personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the town emergency ordinances, which are set forth below:

Evacuation. ***To be announced as necessary.***

Curfew. ***To be announced as necessary.***

No Alcoholic Beverages. ***To be announced as necessary.***

No Firearms, Ammunition, or Explosives. ***To be announced as necessary.***


Execution of Emergency Plan. ***All persons and emergency personnel within the Town of Carolina Beach are ordered to comply with the emergency plan.***

Public Shelters. ***To be announced as necessary.***

This proclamation shall become retroactively effective at 12:00 a.m. on Friday, October 2, 2015.
